Report of Actions on Sunday, June 4, 2017

Convention 2017 was called back to order by President Helen L. Hutchison at 9:00 a.m., on Sunday, June 4, 2017.

Sunday Plenary: 191 Delegates representing 52 Leagues.

Approved the LWVC Bylaws Revision as shown on Pages 86 through 96 of the Convention Workbook

Approved the LWVC Program for 2017-2019

- Retained current positions (Pages 32 through 37 of Convention Workbook)
- Adopted *Making Democracy Work in California* as an Issue for Education and Advocacy during 2017-2019 (Pages 38 and 39 of Convention Workbook)
- Adopted *Natural Resources*, including climate change, water, and land use/CEQA as an Issue for Education and Advocacy during 2017-2019 (pages 39 and 40 of Convention Workbook)
- Adopted response to changing federal policies and budget actions that have an impact on California in areas such as health care, immigration, the environment, tax reform an Issue for Education and Advocacy during 2017-2019 (page 40 of Convention Workbook).
